





Dress Code

- The following items are not allowed per Hall County School District
 - See through clothes
 - Strapless dresses, sundresses
 - Shirts with no side seams
 - Items with suggestive lettering, pictures, symbols, gang relation, alcohol or drug depictions

 - Excessive baggy pants
 - Miniskirts, or mini dresses
 - Leggings without appropriate skirt, short, and/or dress coverage
 - Clothes with holes or slits above the knee
 - **Other general guidelines that may or may not be allowed at school will be given to students at individual schools.

Badges

- Should be kept around the neck at all times during school hours
- Used for

 - check out books from learning commons
 - check in/out of school

Cell Phone Policy


- Cell phones are not to be out during the school day. This includes homeroom and in the hallways.

Consequences:


- <u>1st offense-</u> Cell phone is sent to the office until the end of the day. It MAY be picked up by the student.
