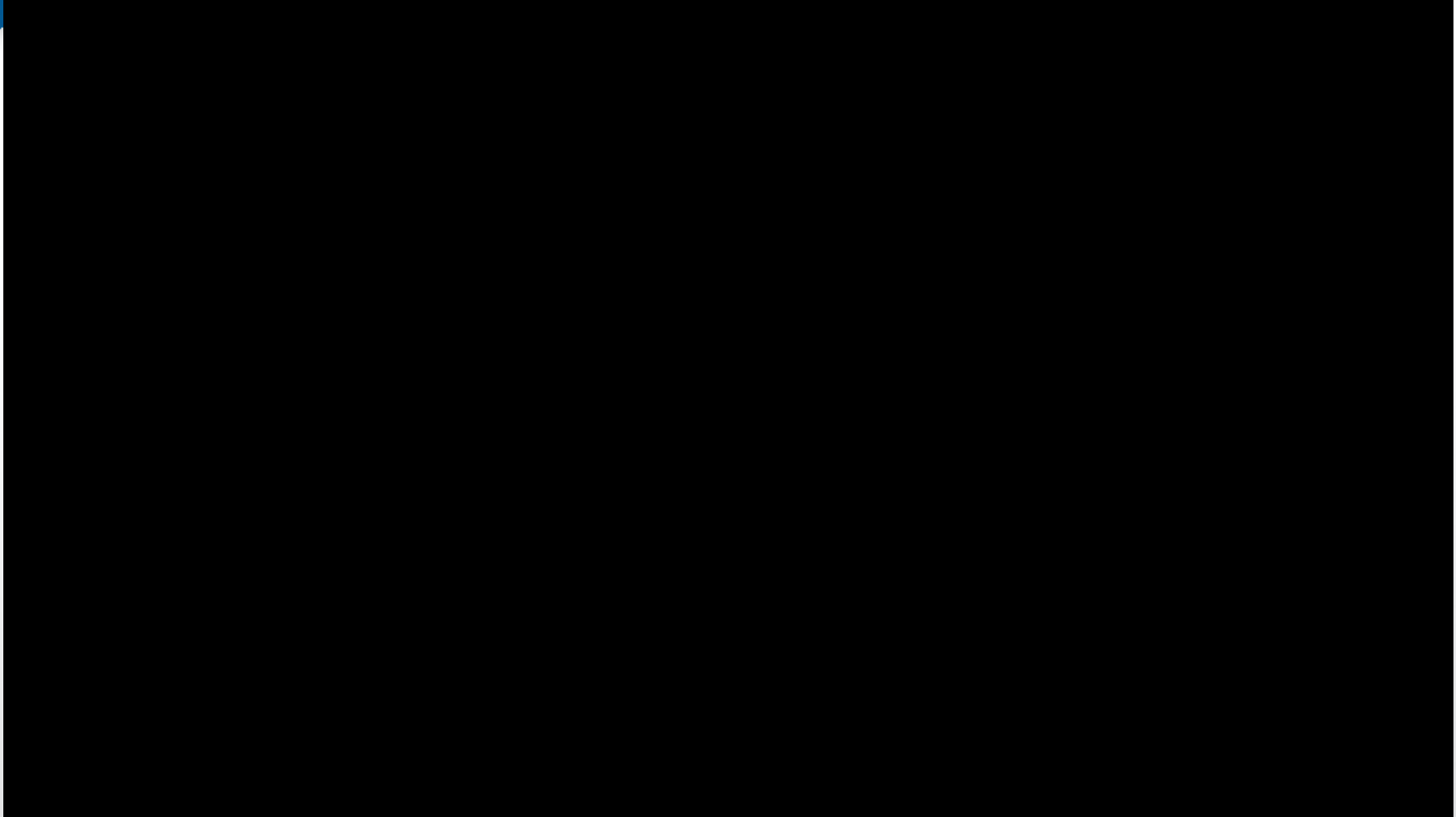

# Dress Code

- The following items are not allowed per Hall County School District
  - See through clothes
  - Strapless dresses, sundresses
  - Shirts with no side seams
  - Items with suggestive lettering, pictures, symbols, gang relation, alcohol or drug depictions

# Badges

# Cell Phone Policy














- Cell phones are not to be out during the school day. This includes homeroom and in the hallways.
- Cell phones must be turned off or on silent in backpacks if brought to school.
- All phone calls/text messages **MUST** be made from the WLA office with permission from supervising teacher.
- **AT NO POINT** should any student be taking photographs or videos of other students, teachers, or staff without the permission of the person.

## Consequences:


- **1st offense**- Cell phone is sent to the office until the end of the day. It **MAY** be picked up by the student.
- **2nd offense**- Cell phone is sent to the office until the end of the day. It may **NOT** be picked up by student, and must be retrieved by parent/guardian.
- **3rd offense**- Cell phone is sent to the office until the end of the day. It may **NOT** be picked up by student, and must be retrieved by the parent/guardian. A parent/teacher conference will be scheduled.




